In addition, they must fulfil one or more of the following criteria:

- On the relevant day and thereafter they continue to be on the electoral register for the parish, or
- During the whole of the twelve months before that day they have owned or tenanted land or premises in the parish, or
- During the whole of the twelve months before that day their principal or only place of work has been in the parish, or
- During the whole of the twelve months before that day they have resided in the parish or within 4.8km (3 miles) of the parish boundary.

Any person who is disqualified from standing for Local Government Elections shall be disqualified from being a member of the Parish Council.

Applicants should be able to demonstrate their involvement and interest in local affairs within the Newchurch Parish Council area and should provide details regarding any appropriate skills that they consider would be of assistance to the Council.

The appointed person must comply with the Code of Conduct, including completing the Register of Financial and other Interests, as it applies to Parish and Town Councillors.
